To create a "science fiction feel" but with historical, biblical and scientific evidence and reason covering creation through the flood. What do I mean? Here are a few examples.

- Original humans reflected the glory of God, physically glowing, Adam and Eve. We see this in Moses when he met with God on the mountain. Have you seen this depicted in Christian art?
- In the original Hebrew which all can look up, the words used for satan in the garden of Eden is "nahas" from a root meaning to hiss or whisper, it means whisper, wise, clever, - but not a literal snake. The interpretation of "Snake" was used as a personification in translation- (see the section on the Garden & Lucifer in STORY on my website). Why is not satan depicted as an angel or demon being, insted of a snake? Adam and Eve could see and interact in the spirit world and see God, so a "talking snake" would be weird, but not a spiritual being talking with them.
- What the Global Flood Cataclysm did to the world, its origins, and mechanisms has not been explored well pictorially or illustrated.




