

## Worldviews

#### A world view is how we make sense of everything around us. It is what we base our beliefs, hopes and truths on.

A world view is why two people looking at the same evidence can come out with different views and conclusions.

#### You never come to the table with nothing. There is no vacuum when it comes to the human experience.

This really matters in the realm of science and exploration, truth and knowing. The question is not whether you can get rid of your bias, but can you see your bias for what it is, a world view, and go beyond it to explore other world views and ideas, being open enough to consider their credibility, origins and conclusions.

What follows are three worldviews which encompass all of the other subsets. Others have explained this better; this is just a skeletal outline. I encourage you to explore further.

#### **Naturalism:** The world and the observable universe came about by

only natural processes. All that exists are time, matter and energy. There is no supernatural in any form. In this camp are atheists, naturalistic (Darwinian) evolutionists, and some agnostics.


#### What this world view believes about:

- Origins— everything came about by chance out of matter, energy, and time. These have always existed, origin unknown.
- Humans the "most evolved" of the living creatures on earth, though may not be the most fit for survival. A product of chance whose only purpose is to survive.
- Morality— morality is tied to survival. The fittest survivor decides the morality. Everything is relative. Right and wrong, good and evil, life and death are just preferences. There are no injustices or wrongs. The majority or the strongest impose their preferences of morality on the weaker. It is just nature being nature.
- Death the end of all things, existence ceases, ending any imagined or created meaning or purpose
- Life you are "god" (the most evolved) so seek your greatest good /survival. Seek pleasure until you die.
- Directives— The only real things are what can be observed in naturalistic/material science. Survival of the fittest—survival of the survivors is the driving force. Chance is the only force or known. The earths well-being supersedes that of any one species, aka, humans. We may be the problem and may need extermination.

**Pantheism:** There is some kind of force, energy or multiple entities which may or may not have brought about the world and the observable universe. They may be part of it as well, but just more evolved beings, separate or entwined in nature. In this camp are Buddhists, Unitarians, pantheists, animists, Hindus, the Greek gods, Guya, Chinese and Japanese folk beliefs, African deities, often Mormonism, etc.

#### What this world view believes about:

- Origins a few creation mythologies, but many pantheist Buddhists and Hindus don't address this issue.
- Humans lower evolutions, part of the system of all things, we must stay in balance or harmony with all things.







# World Views...continued

- Morality it varies upon your evolution level.
- Death maybe the end, maybe not. Definitely the end of your personality as the universe recycles your energy or essence.
- Life seek to be at balance with the universe and with others, but don't get caught in the wrong caste system or the downward spiral of reincarnation. Which evolved entity or force do you listen to in this worldview? Nothing is for sure; just seek peace and love and hang loose, however that is done.
- Directives There is something out there bigger than us. Some great observations about humans, nature, and the universe, but not sure what to do or where to go with them.


**Monotheism / The One:** All existence, reality, knowing, time, energy and matter, start from one being. This being (alien) has always existed, always been, and has no end. This being is outside of time, space, and matter. Life, light, love, relationship, choice, and all things find their source or origin in this being.


#### What this world view believes about:

- Origins All of time, space, energy and life come from this source. The Creation is a reflection of the creator, but not the same as the Creator.
- Humans A special reflection of the creator, designed to be in a unique relationship with the creator.
- Morality Light and dark, good and evil, right and wrong exist outside the human experience and we live the happiest and best when we discover and align ourselves with the harmony of the universe and choose to live connected with the source of life and reality.
- Death the result of separation from the Source. A consequence of choice, our choosing to seek independence from the origin of all things. A transition resulting in rebirth or restoration of all things lost, broken, stolen, or destroyed because of human independence from Life's Source. Or, complete separation resulting in judgment and annihilation.
- Life the opportunity to discover your purpose and connect with the Creator, living out your hopes and dreams and gifts to your fullest potential.
- Directives— learn to live in love, connected to the Source, live in balance and harmony with nature and your fellow humans. Reflect the love, life, and glory and relationship given to us by the Creator, exploring and living in wonder at all that is around us.

Note: Of the three main beliefs, Islam, Judaism and Christianity, only Christianity holds to a being who has love and relationship at its core in a trinity of three personalities of the same essence in perfect harmony with each other, showing themselves to humanity in one Creator. A truly alien and mind-twisting concept. In contrast Islam and Judaism (to some extent) have only one being with love being one trait of that being– much more like the Greek gods of Olympus who loved and hated and had no core nature.

## A Comparison of the Two Main Theories

**Note:** there are many variations between the two, such as theistic evolution, which try to adopt characteristics of the other.

**Key:** In discussing naturalistic evolution and creation theories it will be helpful to distinguish some sets or differences in the animal kingdom. (*More: see page 11*) The broadest sets are invertebrates, vertebrates.

Then mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians, fish, arthropods, starfish, mollusks, segmented worms, roundworms, flatworms, jellyfish, sponges.

Then kinds/ baramins: dog, primate, cat, horse, cow, spider, whale, turtle, lizard, bird etc. Then species: swan, house cat, doberman, draft horse, ape, blue whale, crocodile, etc. **More info:** http://www.answersingenesis.org/get-answers/topic/created-kinds http://www.answersingenesis.org/home/area/cfol/ch2-species.asp





#### Naturalistic Evolution:

Assumption – Time, matter and energy have always existed, and somehow defy the laws of entropy.

This model allows for no outside or intelligent intervention (supernatural). Only time, matter, and energy- only the natural.

**Universe:** from the big bang – origin point out of "nothing" Billions of y.o. 8 to 20 billion y.o.

**Earth & Solar System:** just one of many solar systems and planets, which by chance happens to be in a life zone. Billions of y.o. Earth Approximately 4.3 Billion y.o.

**Life:** By chance arose from non-life chemicals and minerals, possibly in the deep oceans. Billions of v.o.



All life/complex organisms (us) "evolved" from non-life – single cell.



**Creation:** Assumption – A creator being (outside the universe) has always existed, no beginning and no end. This model allows for supernatural intervention in nature and claims that the Creator used natural and supernatural

means in the origin and development of the universe and life on earth and even outside of it.

**Universe:** from an origin point, spoken into existence (created) out of nothing.

Could be billions y.o. or young, thousands y.o. In the Bible, the Earth is talked about first, and the planets, sun, and stars show up later. It could be that they were created billions/millions of years before and their light reached earth on the day described in the Bible – naturalistically. There are some great scientific observations for a young universe that is thousands of years old. There is also the supernatural nature of the Creator, beyond the access of science.

**Earth & Solar system:** designed specifically for life and humanity. It could be millions or thousands of years old. According to the Bible, the earth was formless and void, but it doesn't say for how long until the day / night cycle was started by the Creator initiating time measurement and life.

**Life:** designed and specifically created. Thousands y.o.

All life (simple and complex organisms created and designed within their kinds (original design) before genetic entropy – the Fall possibly introduced mutation and degeneration.





**Natural Selection:** In nature one or more traits will be favored and/or selected out because of environmental conditions.

Adaptation: A living organism's reaction to natural selection. An internal system will enhance traits so that the organism / animal/ human survives better. (Scientifically observed within kinds, called speciation. Darwin's finches or dogs – wolf to Chihuahua.

**Mutation:** change within an organism on the genetic level. Scientifically no new genetic information has ever been observed to be added to an organism by mutation. It works with the existing information. Mutations can be beneficial, neutral, or harmful. The huge majority are harmful.

Naturalistic evolution proposes that these three mechanisms can change one kind of creature into another and that they can- given enough time- take one celled organisms and "evolve" them into a range of different kinds of creatures. This is referred to as macro (large) evolution, and differentiated from micro-evolution, which happens within kinds from the three forces mentioned above.

**Long periods of time:** billions and millions of years. With enough time the improbable or the impossible become possible- is the theory.

**Fossil record:** claims to be able to show millions of years of life and geologic change, Millions y.o.

**Tenants:** the present is the key to the past – uniformitism. (Does not acknowledge that a worldwide cataclysm happened, except whatever wiped out the dinosaurs.)

Reality and morality originate from nature. Existence is only in life on this earth. Death ends everything. There is no pre - or post - existence, no supernatural.



#### Summary:

The key differences between evolution and creation theories are the preexistence of a supernatural creator versus a completely naturalistic world. Billions of years versus thousands for the origin and development of life and the universe. They differ on the scientific viability of natural selection, adaptation and mutation to "evolve" non-life / single cell organism to the multiplicity of complex organisms we see today and in the fossil record. They interpret the fossil record and past events differently.

**Natural selection:** imported from the Fall. The result of sin and separation from the Creator's plan and design.

In nature one or more traits will be favored / selected out because of environmental conditions. This fits both models and is neither evolutionary or creationary.

Adaptation: an amazing design feature enabling creatures to modify or adapt to nature (within kinds) dog, horse, cat, turtle etc.

A living organism's reaction to natural selection. An internal system will enhance traits so that the organism / animal/ human survives better. (Scientifically observed within kinds, called speciation. Darwin's finches or dogs – wolf to Chihuahua.)

**Mutation:** a mechanism designed to assist adaptation. Harmful mutations (possibly all) are the result of the Fall – human's choice against the Creator, separating all of nature and the planet and ushering in degeneration and mutation. All things were created to their optimal use and purpose, but now are diverging or degenerating.

Change within an organism on the genetic level. Scientifically no new genetic information has ever been observed to be added to an organism by mutation. It works with the existing information. Mutations can be beneficial, neutral, or harmful. The huge majority are harmful.

Short periods of time: for life, and possibly other processes

**Fossil record:** no intermediates, but many varieties of creatures affected by a global flood, many not in existence today. Mostly laid down by a global flood catastrophe.

**Tenants:** The present is very different from the past. It has been affected by entropy/degradation and global and local catastrophic events of the past.


Reality and morality originate from the Creator. The supernatural exists, and an afterlife as humans being made in the image of the Creator are designed to exist in a relationship of love and dependence with their Maker forever. The world will be restored and the story will continue and, probably, expand into the rest of the universe as humanity continues to learn and explore the universe created.

## The Godhead

There are many ancient cultures, which have writings pre-dating or separated from Christianity or the Jewish beliefs/writings. The following are their descriptions of this Creator Being.

## 'Before time, and throughout time, there has been a self-existing being, eternal, infinite, complete, omnipresent Outside this being, before the beginning, there was nothing.' (1)

from the writings of the Taoist *Lao-tzu*, who flourished in the China of the 6th century BC, that the following profound statement concerning the existence and some of the attributes of God is taken:

#### 'I am the creator of all things that exist...that came forth from my mouth. Heaven and earth did not exist, nor had been created the herbs of the ground nor the creeping things. I raised them out of the primeval abyss from a state of non-being...' (3)

from an ancient text from Heliopolis in Egypt: It would not be overstating the case to say that the Egyptian concept of a divine creation of the universe was so strongly held that throughout Egypt it governed every sphere of thought and action, political, educational, philosophical and so on. And it is also noteworthy to consider that there is no record anywhere amongst the vast amount of literature to be recovered from ancient Egypt, that suggests that this view was ever challenged. Nowhere in all the long history of Egypt do we find that a philosopher arose who was prepared to propagate the notion that the universe came into being through the agency of non-divine forces and processes.

## 'First of all the Void came into being ...next Earth ...Out of the Void came darkness ...and out of the Night came Light and Day...' (7)


this from the early Greeks we have the Theogony of Hesiod (8th century BC) an account of the creation of the world that bears unmistakable and remarkably close similarities with the Genesis account:

'Homer and Hesiod attributed to the gods all the things which among men are shameful and blameworthy--theft and adultery and mutual deception...[But] there is one God, greatest among gods and men, similar to mortals neither in shape nor in thought ...he sees as a whole, he thinks as a whole, he hears as a whole ...Always he remains in the same state, changing not at all ...But far from toil he governs everything with his mind.' (8)

#### Outside of life, what were two of the greatest gifts God gave us/ humanity?

- We chose to believe and trust in ourselves, our word and satins' lies over God and his word. We believed the lie of independence and self.



This is entirely wrong. God had already given Adam dominion over the earth, and good stewardship requires knowledge of what one is responsible for. In other words, science is almost commanded. So what is this tree all about?

- first, Adam and Eve already knew good. They knew God. In the New Testament, Jesus stated in Mark 10:18 (and parallel verses in Matthew and Luke), "Why do you call me good? no one is good -- except God alone." So there is no doubt that Adam and Eve knew good and the Source of good.
- that only leaves evil. Evil is the result of sin. Sin is defined by the law (Romans 7:7-11, etc.). So sin is disobedience to the law of God and evil is the result of all that.
- God only gave Adam one law: don't eat from that particular tree.
- Why did God give Adam an opportunity to disobey? Because without the opportunity to disobey, **obedience** means nothing more than something that is programmed in, like an instinct. But men have a choice where God is concerned. If you think about your children you will see something. They disobey, and probably fairly often. But that means when they do obey, it is special. Jesus told His followers, **"If you love me, you will obey what I command."** (John 14:15). It is through obedience we can show love to God.
- Jesus said the most important command was to love, first God, with everything in you, and then your neighbor as yourself (Matthew 22:34-40). We were created to love. But if love can be commanded, that means it is not a feeling. Feelings come along for the ride, and often plenty of them. But love itself is a decision one makes to serve another, care for another, commit to another. Loving God, for us, means serving him, caring for His reputation through our representation of Him, and committing to Him. We can choose this or choose against this. Choosing this implies obeying Him and choosing against this implies running our own lives in obedience to our sin natures. Adam and Eve did not have sin natures, at first. But they had the freedom of choice which God has given each of us.
- The Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil was therefore the opportunity given Adam and Eve to freely choose to obey and love God, maintaining their relationship with Him....or not.
- Thus, what was forbidden about the tree was not knowledge, and not knowledge of the good, but rather knowledge of good as compared to evil, which meant knowledge of evil. Evil came from disobedience and this caused the breaking of the relationship with God. It was this God did not want for them.

In this Story we discover what happened to us, our gender roles, value, social structure etc., and how to reverse it. Genesis speaks of male and female value 1:26,27; we in his image, but man is singled out as responsible—and image bearer. God gives them unique and special roles, blesses and speaks with them. They are equally endowed and equally valuable just with different roles.

**Genesis 2 reveals a social structure.** Adam is given an occupation and responsibility before Eve's creation. Gen 2:15. Adam is shown by God how to lead with his words 2:16-17. Adam was to actively pass this word on to Eve and his descendents. God establishes functional community echoed in Eph. 5:25-26, a servant–leader. God provides them with relationship roles. Gen 2:18 God calls man out to be the social and spiritual leader. Male domination is a personal moral failure– part of our Fall. It is not a teaching of the Bible. Adam names his wife/helper (one called into) and is called to initiate a new household. Gen 2:23-24

#### The Fall / temptation seeks to corrupt and reverse God's original social and spiritual order. Gen 3:1-6

God holds Adam, not Eve accountable for Humanities first sin. Gen 3:8-9

Adam's actions show a self-centered passivity (the death of self -reliance)

In the curse, God seeks to show them that they will seek satisfaction and identity in work– for Adam, and in marital relationship/man—for Eve and they will not find it. These areas were to be an expression of our true Identities and worship, not the place for finding them.

## EDEN & THE FALL

The Deception/Fall Lucifer/Satan in Eden as a guardian Trusted – the whisperer Purpose – to destroy our relationship with our Maker





A few places in the Bible it indicates that Satan/Lucifer walked in the garden before his fall and may have even been a guardian over Eden. **Ezekiel 28: 11-19** Luke 10:18

#### A Lament over the King of Tyre (follows the Lament over the Prince—a person ) see Daniel 10:13

<u>11</u>Moreover, the word of the LORD came to me: <u>12</u>"Son of man, raise a lamentation over the king of Tyre, and say to him, Thus says the Lord GOD:

"You were the signet of perfection, full of wisdom and perfect in beauty.

**13** You were in Eden, the garden of God; every precious stone was your covering, sardius, topaz, and diamond, beryl, onyx, and jasper, sapphire, emerald, and carbuncle; and crafted in gold were your settings

and your engravings.<sup> $\frac{2}{2}$ </sup> On the day that you were created they were prepared.

14 You were an anointed guardian cherub. I placed you; you were on the holy mountain of God; in the midst of the stones of fire you walked.

**15** You were blameless in your ways from the day you were created, till unrighteousness was found in you.

<u>16</u> In the abundance of your trade you were filled with violence in your midst, and you sinned; so I cast you as a profane thing from the mountain of God, and I destroyed you, O guardian cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.

**<u>17</u>** Your heart was proud because of your beauty; you corrupted your wisdom for the sake of your splendor.

I cast you to the ground; I exposed you before kings, to feast their eyes on you.

**18** By the multitude of your iniquities, in the unrighteousness of your trade you profaned your sanctuaries;

- so I brought fire out from your midst; it consumed you, and I turned you to ashes on the earth in the sight of all who saw you.
- 19 All who know you among the peoples are appalled at you; you have come to a dreadful end and shall be no more forever.

Perhaps this is why Eve trusted him, and was led astray. In the original Hebrew and Alexandrian XXL texts it says the Whisper came to Eve. Serpent was only used later as an analogy. Satan now the Deceiver came and whispered to Eve.

# LXX: And the LORD God gave a charge to Adam, saying, Of every tree which is in the garden you may freely eat [literally: eat for food], but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil – of it you shall not eat, but in whatsoever day you eat of it, you shall die by death.

• the biblical definition of death is not 'unconsciousness' as we think of it. It is, rather, 'separation.' Physical death is separation from the body. The 'second death' is separation from God. At no time is there any indication in either the New or Old Testaments that loss of consciousness on the part of the soul is involved.

the actual phrase translated 'surely die,' and 'die by death,' is, in the Hebrew, 'in dying you will die.' This indicates two deaths which will take place, one being physical and the other a separation from fellowship with God.



## **Genesis 3:1** — Now the serpent was more crafty [King James: 'subtle'] than any of the wild animals the LORD God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden'?"

The word for serpent is 'nahas,' from a root meaning to hiss or whisper, as in a magic spell. The root also implies to foretell, with the implication of a divine enchanter or enchantment. Related words mean 'enchantment.' Interestingly, the word is related to the Chaldean word for 'copper or brass.' A variant of 'nahas' spelled the same way with different pronunciation, means divination, to interpret an omen, or learn by divination or sorcery. The root word also means to learn by experience or diligently observe.

It is interesting that the Greek word used for the serpent (in reference to Satan) in the Bible also does not mean 'snake' at all, but refers to sharpness of vision, a cunning or malicious person. What does need to be said is that the snake, or serpent, has been used as a type for this for a very long time, possibly since before the Flood. In many ancient and pagan cultures, the serpent is the source of wisdom. 'Crafty' is an interesting word. "Arum" is used eleven times in OT and eight times translated at 'prudent.' It is 6175 in the Strongs: cunning, crafty, prudent, subtle. Related to the word meaning 'cunning' is a word meaning 'to make bare, smooth, to be cunning, to take crafty counsel, be prudent, deal subtly'.

The meaning is the serpent – or the hisser or whisperer – is being extremely careful about what he is doing. In terms of the understanding of the ancient Hebrew scholars who translated the paleo Hebrew to classical Greek several hundred years before Christ (the Alexandrian Septuagint), the meaning included the characteristic of maliciousness on Satan's part. This whisperer's first words recorded are a challenge about what God has said, an attempt to raise doubt. It should be noted that that will always be the first part most temptations today. It can be disguised as "Is it really right that....?" or "Do you think it is fair that....?" Remember Proverbs 1 and other places: "*The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and discipline.*" An appeal to 'right' or 'fair' is simply one step down from an appeal to God, since it is He who has pronounced what is right and fair and just.

**Genesis 3:2-3** – The woman said to the serpent, "We may eat fruit from the trees in the garden, but God did say, 'You must not eat fruit from the tree that is in the middle of the garden, and you must not touch it, or you will die.""

In the Judgment God hands down to the Deceiver (serpent) He uses a word picture we miss, but the Hebrews would have totally understood.

## **Genesis 3:13** – Then the LORD God said to the woman, "What is this you have done?" The woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate."

Each person is given a chance to accept responsibility before God, and thus to repent. Eve, however, claims deception and evidently that is the truth, despite the fact that she chose to depend on her own ideas rather than God's command. So this brings up the question, Why did Eve believe the serpent? And that is why we spent time last week on Ezekiel. If Satan/Lucifer were the guardian cherub of Eden, then Eve would have been used to him and would have thought he could be trusted. She would have associated him with God's protection of them.


# **Genesis 3:14-15** – So the LORD God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this, cursed are you above all the livestock and all the wild animals! You will crawl on your belly and you will eat dust all the days of your life. And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers. He will crush your head and you will strike his heel."



If 'serpent' is the Whisperer or Hisser, and he is to go on his belly from thence forward, what is the possible meaning? The 'go on your belly' phrase in the ancient cultures was indicative of total subservience, as to a king. People would approach a king lying flat out on the ground, and one of the signs of total dominion was for the king to put his foot on the person who was on the ground. Keep that picture in mind for a moment.

If we are heading in the right direction here, then we are not talking about an actual glorified snake in the garden, but about the glorified cherub who was guardian over Eden (and possibly more) and proud because of his beauty. To this being who deceived Eve, then, God says "you will be totally subservient all the days of your life, on your belly." He will not be able to challenge God in wisdom or beauty, as he originally wanted to do. He will be severely limited in what he can do. But the rest of the prophesy is also not what tradition tells us. What does the phrase 'eat dust' mean? There have been so many studies about how snakes 'taste' dust with their flicking tongues. But what Genesis is saying is not about a snake and not about 'eating dust,' if we go back to the early meanings of the words. God is prophesying here about something that will happen in the future -- something they saw before the Flood and something we see today. Satan is devouring the earth. THAT is the meaning of the words so often translated 'eat dust.' The ancient Alexandrian LXX says Satan will 'eat the earth all the days of your life.' The word 'eat' is also 'devour,' and not simply masticating and swallowing. The word so often translated 'dust' is the same word used in **Genesis 1:1** -- "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth (cretz)."

Satan will be allowed to work his evil, but only on earth. Was he then originally not just the guardian cherub of Eden, but of the entire earth? In Job 1 when God asks Satan, rhetorically, where he has been, Satan says he has been walking back and forth on the earth. So for a time, Satan is allowed earth. This is why he offered Christ, in the third temptation, the dominion over all the earth's kingdoms. They were his temporarily. We also find an oblique reference to this in Ephesians 6, where we learn our battle is not against flesh and blood but *"against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms."* 




Again, we are not trying to present salvation doctrine here, so it is not vital that you believe one way or another about Satan in the garden. We simply wanted to present to you what it appears the original may have been saying as opposed to the traditional translations. Either way, Eve was deceived, got Adam to eat, and sin entered the world. That is the important part.

Then God goes on talking to Satan, stating there will be enmity between him and the woman. We mentioned this before, but it is interesting that it is normally the woman who must be talked into doing wrong. Women seem to have more of an instinctive aversion to evil; they seem to draw away more

quickly. At least when they are young! This enmity will continue between the offspring of both, but here God puts in a qualifier: *"he will crush your head and you will strike his heel."* 

First of all, the woman's offspring will conquer Satan himself, disabling him completely and then killing him. It will not be offspring against offspring in this sense. Rather, the Savior will go back to the source. Second, the woman's offspring is here defined as one man, not a number of people. And, finally, this man will have his heel struck by Satan.

Think about that picture of going on his belly and a king putting his foot on the subservient one. In ancient battles in the Middle East, the winning king would put his foot on the supine body of the losing king. We see this in Joshua 10, where he had been victorious over the five kings and put them in a cave. Then, *"so it was, when they brought out those kings to Joshua, that Joshua called for all the men of Israel, and said to the captains of the men of war who went with him, 'Come near, put your feet on the necks of these kings.' " Afterwards Joshua killed the five kings. It was the victor's choice to kill or not kill* 



the losing king. The picture now becomes more clear. If Christ's foot is proverbially on Satan, who is on his belly, Satan can either lie still or try to strike back. The only possible place to strike the victor is on the foot itself. And so Satan does, striking Christ's heel. Down or not, Satan is going to strike back as much as he is able.

What things around us and in us are the results / effects of our fall / choice against God?

Your talents — what you like to do, what your good at.

What makes you come alive? The glory of God is seen in a man or woman fully alive.

What spiritual gifts are you given, what others is God calling you to exercise and seek.

#### How have you entered into His story, His Kingdom?

Do you know what God wants of you?

Do you know His story – how we fit into it? Verse – love God, love others

What has He given you to invest and use in his Kingdom, in reaching out to the lives and hearts of people?

Are you going to live your life and story our join your life and story into his adventure and live in the adventure of our Creator.

#### Based on your worldview, here is how you might answer these issues. How you answer life's questions largely depends on your worldview, and this determines what kind of story you will write with your life.

#### Issue

#### **Naturalistic Evolution (NE)**

#### Supernatural Creation (SC)

**Note:** I am not saying all NE or SC believe the things stated from their worldviews, but there is justification for what is stated coming from these worldviews.



Under a NE view, the government is an evolution of human rules and systems. This is a Roman Law system where human rights and freedoms are granted or withheld by the State. If the State deems there is no property ownership, it makes stealing irrelevant. In some countries like China this meant the State owned everything, even the people, and could force abortions, property sales, and determine work weeks. In this model, citizens only have the rights the State gives them.

Under a SC view, the government is an institution created by God who must answer to God via the people for protecting and safeguarding the rights of the people. Liberty and rights are given by the Creator and cannot be lawfully taken away by governments or states. This is a Hebrew Law system. The Ten commandments is a basis for this system.

**Note on American Politics:** America was founded in a SC view of government, one only need to read the Constitution or Bill of Rights to understand this or see the Ten Commandments and biblical figures carved into the doors, walls, and the sides of our capital's buildings. Now the people and politicians of America are forgetting our historical roots and justice system by forming a Roman system based on sole rule of the government where the State displaces God as the arbiter of laws, freedoms and rights.

# **HEALTH CARE**

Under the NE view, the state determines rights, so it may say we all have the right to health care and we must all pay for others' health or lack of it. The State can force you to have whatever coverage it dictates and make all pay for it. It removes personal responsibility for how one's behavior affects ones health and others around them. This is often called socialism — the concept that the State is the giver of benefits, property, etc., and that all work (lazy or hard), should be rewarded the same or evenly distributed. Therefore, if you work hard, pay taxes, stay off drugs, smoking, obesity, things that damage your body, etc., you must pay for the health care of others who smoke, eat to obesity, etc. (70% of our diseases are self-caused by lifestyle or our drugs — health care: From the documentary, "Fat, Sick & Nearly Dead.")


Under the SC view, health care is not a right, but an individual's responsibility before their creator. Individuals are responsible for taking care of their own health and healthcare needs. Then, we are called to care for others who can not care for themselves, in this worldview, but it is not mandatory or funneled through the government. For most of Earth's history, healthcare as we currently know it, has not existed. Is it a "Basic Human Right" as some would assert? And who is responsible for the cost of this "right"?



Under the NE view, there are two schools of thought. One sees human survival as the greatest good, the other sees nature's /the planet's survival as the greatest good. Most fall into the second school. They believe that the planet/environment must be protected at all cost, not for humanity's sake, but for Nature's sake.

So what are the greatest threats to our planet? We humans are, and the solution could be anything from reducing population to boycotting industrialization, free-enterprise "capitalistic" markets to taxing carbon dioxide emissions and saving the rain forests. In this view, this planet and future is all we have, and we can destroy humanity's future and existence quite easily. Under the SC view, the Creator gives the responsibility of taking care of our planet and environment to humanity. We are to be wise and generous with our natural resources, not hoarding them for money or power. We should be concerned about our environment, rainforests, oceans, etc. In this worldview humans are not the threat; they are the solution. If we align ourselves with the Creator we will not destroy and covet our planet, but instead use our creativity to find solutions to pollution and energy problems. It is human greed and selfishness, not humanity itself, that is to blame. We also understand that the planet is caught in the separation from God and is degenerating (entropy). Our final home and hope is not just this planet which will wear out, but a restored planet and people.

**Note on environment:** Both views agree on taking care of the planet, ourselves and the environment. It is the motivations and solutions that we differ on.



# **Global Warming**

Global warming is one of the most popular environmental issue today. There are radically different causes and answers depending on your worldviews. Assumption: the earth is warming. There is plenty of data and research showing that it may or may not be happening, but for the sake of this illustration, let's assume that it is happening.

The earth is millions of years old in the NE view, and so knowing what is causing global warming is hard to judge. In current politics and pop-science, humans are to blame for the warming of the earth. It is billed as a "save the environment campaign," but if you watch Al Gore, it seems like it is a "save the humans and our cities campaign." Or it may be a great way to gain control and make millions of dollars off of people's fear.

If ocean levels rise and the earth warms, the plants and animals will adjust and evolve, and the earth will cycle itself into a cold/ice-age phase, as in the movie "Day after Tomorrow." It may definitely mess with your next vacation, but will make for a great story. Is this a real and current problem or just a way for a few to make millions by taxing nations and people for their pollution and carbon emissions.

Remember you're breathing out CO2 – carbon, so you may be part of the problem.

The earth could be millions of years old in the SC view, but is more likely under ten thousand years old and has been shaped by supernatural and cataclysmic processes. In this view the earth and its systems were created perfect and in harmony, but with the fall of humanity away from their Maker, the planet suffers this separation as well. The environment is deteriorating as a result of humanity's choices, both physical and spiritual. Between 4 and 8 thousand years ago a global flood ravaged the planet, changing the earth and the environment forever. Because of plate movement and volcanism, the oceans warmed and caused an ice age lasting for a couple hundred years. After the flood cataclysm, the planet and its sedimentary rocks were saturated with water. The planet sometimes violently shed this water as continents shifted, rose, or fell. The earth has been drying out. We see this in desert growth and formation, the study of historic people and civilizations, etc. Global warming if it is occurring, is part of this planet's cycle of "drying out." The major factors are the sun, which creates the ozone layer, and helps regulate it's thickness, the oceans - holders of the vast amount of carbon dioxide, and volcanism. The human factor and influence on global warming may be small to irrelevant, But we humans like to make everything about us, right?

## **Body Image and Fitness**

In the NE view, your body is all you have and the purpose of evolution is survival and propagation. Basically, what ever helps you get ahead, procreate, and survive best is what is good for you. What if you are deformed, handicapped, ugly or even of a non-white race? Some would argue that you are not the fittest to survive. This is not too popular now, but it was in the past. It was called Nazism — Arianism, Eugenics, and we see this pervasive idea in ethnic cleansing. Also, it is startling and outrageous that there is more sex trafficking and human slavery today than in the days of open slavery in early America. How can this be justified? Well if we live in the world of NE then nothing is "wrong." The motto is survival of the fittest. Oh, and you are just an evolved animal with no more intrinsic value than a monkey, dog, or rat.

In the SC view, we are designed and created with value and a purpose because of our creator. We are to take care of our bodies and not mistreat / abuse them. Though we may not be the strongest or prettiest, we have just as much value and importance as the "stars" of this world. We know that this world and us are separated from the renewing power of God, so we are ravaged by disease, genetic degeneration and entropy. Whenever we are attacked by cancer, disease and even death, we should cry out for the return of God and restoration. Only humans are made in the image of God and have a special value to our creator over the animals. We should not mistreat or abuse animals, as we are their guardians. It is an offense to our Creator to denigrate, enslave or put down one of His children.

## **Sex and Marriage**

In the world of NE, marriage is just a socially evolved arrangement and is always changing and evolving. Therefore, family can be same-sex partners or you and your dog. There are no real boundaries to stick to. It is a preference and social convention. Sex in a NE world developed to propagate the species. It has no higher purpose than pleasure and propagation. In this view, taboo sexual practices, slavery, pornography, etc., are only "wrong" if society deems them so. Since morality is up to preference and perception, almost anything goes or could go in this world.

In the world of SC, Marriage and family are a design of a creator for the safety and stability of the family and society. This design safeguards children and gives roles with equality. Deviations from this design will often lead to destructive practices and a distortion of society. Sex, though enjoyable and for propagation, is meant to bond a man and woman in marriage. Sex for its own end never fully satisfies, and most often outside of marriage becomes the focus of the relationship, often destroying real love and taking the relationship off balance. Sex is seen as a beautiful and wonderful gift that strengthens and mades marriage enjoyable. It may also lead to our destruction when distorted and used for self-serving purposes. The distortions of marriage and sex in our society are a result of our separation from God, degeneration of society, and genetics and the selfishness of humans.

## Abortion

In the world of NE, survival of the fittest, abortion is just a part of nature. The least fit don't survive. So whether society, government, or and individual wants to abort a human, NE has no argument against it except that if we all do it, the human race will reduce in size and maybe even cease to survive. In the SC view, all life is precious, and even death by self-defense is a detrimental and unwanted occurrence though necessary for survival. God's original world did not include death of intelligent complex creatures. Abortion is the destruction of one of God's most special creations and is most undesirable, with sad and unfortunate and evil consequences.



In the world of NE, all the races are literally fighting for survival. If one uses a made up religion to dominate others, well that is OK. Isn't the only axiom of nature, survival? We have the Muslims, Arabs, Palestinians wanting to wipe out the Israelis/Jews, than why is that wrong?

Was what Americans did to the native Indians wrong? The slavery of African people, the Nazi/ German extermination of the Jews, Gypsies, and handicapped, or the extermination of the Chinese by the Japanese, just to give a few examples. In the NE view none of these actions was "wrong" it was just the "preservation of favored races in the struggle for life" - This was part of the alternate title of Darwin's "The Origin of Species" 1859 In the world of SC, the people of Israel were one of God's ways of reaching down to humanity. They were a specially chosen people, who were blessed to be a blessing and reach the world with the love of the Creator. God has a special place for Israel and a continuing purpose. Those who wish to destroy and infringe upon Israel are going against God's wishes. God says He gave them the land of Canaan/Israel and that those who curse them will be cursed, and those who bless them will be blessed.

**Note on Middle East Conflict:** The Palestiniens / Arabs and the Isrealis both have been wronged and have done wrong, but Israel is surrounded by Arab/Muslim nations. The true historical name of the West Bank is Judea. Why don't the other Arab nations, in the spirit of brotherly love, invite the Palestinians into their lands and homes? I am sure Allah will look down on them in favor for such a generous action.

## **Other Beliefs or Religions**

In the view of NE, all beliefs in unscientific, provable phenomenon are illogical and superstitious. Therefore, all religions are human fairytales invented for weak minds and simple, foolish people.



In the view of SC, there is only one Creator and source of all knowledge and truth. Humans have been given the freedom to choose and think what they want. This leads to beliefs which contradict the reality of a Creator or totally disavow his existence. All beliefs do not lead to the same Creator of Humanity, because they describe different realities, Gods, and ways of being restored to that Creator.

**Clarke's Three Laws** are three <u>"laws"</u> of prediction formulated by the British writer and scientist <u>Arthur C. Clarke</u>. They are:

1. When a distinguished but elderly scientist states that something is possible, he is almost certainly right. When he states that something is impossible, he is very probably wrong.

2. The only way of discovering the limits of the possible is to venture a little way past them into the impossible.

3. Any sufficiently advanced technology is indistinguishable from magic.

## Popular Media, Movies, and Music

In the view of NE most everything is permissible as long as it fulfills you or gives you purpose. Selfgratification and pleasure are the norm, and there is no greater message or story than our fantasies.



In the view of SC, these are all neutral mediums conveying the hearts and messages of the people producing them. If the intent is to wrestle or celebrate life or to worship the creator, then these medium will inspire you, bring life, and bring you closer to your Maker. If on the other hand they celebrate death, destruction, and things unproductive and destroying the message and name of God, then you will find loss and despair in these things. They will only leave you trapped and dissatisfied with their promises because they are terrorists to the way of life. Movies and music can retell the original stories of journey, sacrifice, true love, loss and restoration. Some intentionally do this, others without intent retell our story of our relationship to our Creator.

### **Ghosts**, **Demons**

In the view of NE, ghosts and demons do not exist and are a part of the un-scientific, unreal world. If all that exists is the natural, then where is the place for the supernatural in the solely atheistic world of NE?

In the view of SC, the existence of ghosts and demons do not negate science, learning or scientific understand. It does argue that there is more to the world. There are answers beyond what we have currently explored scientifically. Just because something can not be controlled, reproduced, and experimented on, doesn't mean it is not real.

#### Afterlife

In the world of NE, all that there is is time, energy, and matter. Once you die, you cease to exist. Or the more open evolutionest will say that after we die, nobody knows. Therefore, to believe in an afterlife is foolish. All you have is this life. In the world of SC, life is a completion of the natural and supernatural worlds. What we do in this life echoes in the next. In this world, all reality originates in the Creator, and to seek separation from this Being, is to chose death, its aftermath and annihilation. Our world is reeling from our choices against this Creator. The coming judgment and restoration will take place in this world and the seperation of "worlds" will end.

## A Creator — God

In the view of NE, there is no Creator, and the very processes and mechanisms, natural selection, mutations and "evolution" as popular believed, eliminate the need and existence for a Creator. The NE view does not work with or cohabitate with the SC view. Those who seek to blend them in Theistic Evolution saying God used evolution are tricking themselves. One view inevitability ends up destroying the key components of the other. For example: the Bible clearly states that death is a result of Humanity's choice to separate ourselves from the Creator. It clearly entered the world by/ because of man, and it will be eradicated and reversed by the Creator/Man, Jesus Christ. This concept is eradicated by "evolution," because death is a natural part of nature. It existed long before humans came into existence. In the world of NE, you have a fictitious Jesus dying for fictitious "sin" to restore us to a nonexistent world and Creator. Many others have argued this better, but you get the picture.

In the view of SC, the exploration and use of science leads us to the conclusion that our origins must be of supernatural nature. The complexity and design of our world and life indicate a planner, designer, and creator. All our models illustrate this. Buildings and machines do not form themselves and self replicate. All things will degenerate. They tend to disorder, and this Second Law of Thermodynamics (the most well known and scientifically founded law in our universe,) means that our origins and organization could have not self originated or organized into the incredible complexity we see today.

In the view of SC, food is to be the individual's and communities responsibility. Food with the least amount of human intervention is the best food for us. Producing food is an important and respectable profession and needs to be safeguarded and preserved. Keep government and mega corporations from controlling food raising, production and distribution. Some NE's have similar views to the SC view on food.

What is this farming system - and why did it cause the Irish Potato Famine? One word: monoculture. In case you're not familiar with the term, it simply means growing a single crop over a wide area. That's the very picture of how we grow food here in America today. Just take a drive through Nebraska, and you'll see what I mean. You can drive past cornfields for hours on end until you want to scream from the monotony. But that's the way we farm today - industrial agriculture. Giant growers typically choose one type of plant - corn, wheat, and soy are the biggies here in the U.S. - that performs well, and plant acres and acres of just that one type. In fact, almost all of the fruits and vegetable varieties you find in the store today are grown that way. It's Henry Ford's assembly line method applied to agriculture. Growers just want lots and lots of food per acre, and it doesn't matter much to them how it tastes or how nutritious it is.

#### Parenting

In the view of NE, parenting can be done by the parents and equally well by the state/government. In some Communist countries the ownership of children was the State. ## **Education / Schooling**

In the view of NE, education is definitely the domain of the government or society. The parents may not know better. The State or Power is here to rescue us from our ineptitude and "religious" nonsense. In the view of SC, education is the responsibility of the parents/family. Character cannot be taught apart from a Creator centered world view.

## History

In the view of NE, history is changeable and evolving. It is the most "fit/survivors" who write history. There is only interpretation and viewpiont. Not truth. The "strongest" in society should or does dictate what history is taught. Only Natural history is allowable. Any history originating in or influenced by the Supernatural is irrelevant and foolish. In the view of SC, history in all its forms, cultural and scientific is revealed though God as well as human recording. History is best understood in a Creator centered world view.
